## ABOUT OUR ROOMS

### VIP DINING ROOMS

These three rooms have glass doors and windows that overlook the Walk of Fame. Panel doors between the VIP Rooms can open up to accommodate 58 diners. The memorabilia in each room is themed for Jack Nicklaus, Fred Taylor or Woody Hayes. VIP I hosts a billiard table for play, or it can be covered for dining.

**One VIP Room:** Seats up to 18 guests conference style or 20 at round tables

**Two VIP Rooms:** Seat 36 guests conference style or 40 guests at round tables

**Three VIP Rooms:** Seat up to 58 guests at a combination of rounds and conference style.

### BILLIARDS ONE and BILLIARDS TWO

On the Main Level, these two rooms are semi-private since they do not have a private entrance or floor to ceiling walls. The close proximity to the Trophy Bar and Restaurant as well as to the Arena Game Room makes them ideal for fun and casual dining or receptions.

Billiards 1 seats 36 guests, Billiards 2 Seats 72 guests.

Both offer access to Billiards and Hand Shuffleboard tables.

### BUCKEYE BALLROOM and WOODY HAYES BALLROOM

Located on our lower level, the décor and ambiance of the Buckeye Ballroom is traditional with neutral décor and a built-in Service Bar. It can be divided into four (4) separate rooms to accommodate Banquets, Meetings, Rehearsal Dinners, or Wedding Receptions for up to 130 guests.

The attributes of the Woody Hayes Ballroom are the same as for the Buckeye Ballroom, except that it cannot be divided into separate room.

### SCARLET BALLROOM

The chandeliered jewel of the Buckeye Hall of Fame Café, the Scarlet Ballroom was renovated in late 2005 with new carpeting and an inlaid hardwood dance floor. Located on the southwest side of our facility, this 10,000 sq ft multi-purpose room can accommodate up to 600 people for a meeting or banquet.
